**NCDOT TO HOLD CORRIDOR-WIDE MEETINGS THIS WEEK ON BUSINESS 40  
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

*Public input will help shape the future of transportation in downtown Winston-Salem*

**RALEIGH** — The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold three corridor-wide meetings this week to gather public input and present new information on the Business 40 improvement project in downtown Winston-Salem.

The meetings will be held:

- Tuesday, June 10, from 5 to 8 p.m.  
Anderson Center at Winston-Salem State University  
Reynolds Park Drive off Martin Luther King Jr. Drive
- Wednesday, June 11, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.  
Sawtooth Building Amphitheatre in Winston Square Park  
226 N. Marshall St.  
(In case of inclement weather, the meeting will be moved into the Sawtooth Building ballroom.)
- Thursday, June 12, from 5 to 8 p.m.  
R.J. Reynolds High School Cafeteria  
301 N. Hawthorne Road

The meetings are informal, and citizens are welcome to drop in at any time during the stated hours. Each meeting will include a brief description of where NCDOT is in the Business 40 study process, an update on outreach efforts and the results of surveys completed by local residents and businesses. The department will also present new traffic data, different improvement scenarios and other project-related information.

In addition, NCDOT will present a list of concerns raised by the public and give citizens an opportunity to provide their feedback. The department will use the list to identify the issues of greatest importance to the community and create special working groups to address each one.

NCDOT will have Spanish interpreters at each meeting, and the Arts Council of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County will provide free food and beverages. Childcare will be available through the project consultant, Neighborhood Solutions Inc.
